## Professional Biography

• Dr. Zainab AlMeraj: is the acting chair and an associate professor at the Information Science Department at the College of Life Sciences, Kuwait University. Her current research interests include usability and accessibility of mobile and web technologies - Human Computer Interaction (HCI), computer graphics (CG), Mathematics and how interdisciplinary research can contribute to the advancement of technologies and human rights awareness. AlMeraj has previously worked on promoting computer science and mathematics to students across Canada and continues to do so in Kuwait. She has acted as a reviewer for highly reputable computing conferences and journals; launched and leads active non-government grassroots organization; acted as a official NGO representative of her efforts in ratifying the UN convention of rights of a child, women and persons with disabilities and serves as a national representative under the Kuwait National Diwan for Human Rights in the persons with disabilities committee since 2020. AlMeraj is a certified consultant in usability and accessibility and uses this experience to advocate for digital accessibility for persons with disabilities on the NGO, academic and entrepreneurial levels.

AlMeraj has several social entrepreneur efforts that started after running as a supervisor of the ClickIT club at Kuwait University and discovering a need for an open, collaborative and inclusive developer community in Kuwait. She first established Women Techmakers Kuwait (focused on women in tech empowerment) which then morphed into the Google Developer Group GDG Kuwait City, a tech group offering a platform to excel talent, find jobs, develop technology and network. She is also a certified trainer in the Google #IamRemarkable program for promoting women empowerment, self leadership and confidence. AlMeraj also established the Arab Women in Computing Kuwait chapter, initiated the conception of ACM HCI Kuwait chapter, and is currently developing a mentoring platform for women in tech and a social community supporting women entrepreneurs. AlMeraj is also a member of the Association of Computing Machinery (ACM) since 2007, User Experience Professional Association (UXPA) since 2018 and the International Association of Accessibility Professionals (IAAP) since 2020.

Since 2014, AlMeraj has worked on preparing shadow reports for the UN OHCHR on four of the nine conventions signed by the State of Kuwait on human rights concerning women, children, domestic workers, illegal residents and people with disabilities. Dr. AlMeraj has continuously devoted her professional, volunteer and social career for technical skill advancement, youth empowerment, awareness, advocacy and implementation of human rights and social justice on the individual, organizational and social policy levels.

Based on this experience, and being a Certified Professional for Usability and User Experience (UXQB) and Certified Professional in Accessibility Core Competencies (CPACC - IAAP) AlMeraj launched an entrepreneurial initiative focused on awareness and effective incorporation and implementation of accessibility and usability in tech projects, so all people are equally "able" to have great user experiences using software on desktop and mobile devices. Since then she was invited to serve as an expert reviewer to develop an Authorized Arabic Translation of WCAG 2.1 Accessibility guideline and the ICT Accessibility and Inclusive Design competency framework lead by MADA, Qatar. AlMeraj is a country representative of Kuwait in the National Diwan for Human Rights (for people with disabilities) and for the G3ICT international initiative. She seeks to help embed digital accessibility into Kuwait organizations from education to commerce and report advances under the National Human Rights Directive.
